#### Ride of Silence

- Way to let know that “bikes belong;” 42 folks came out in Harrisonburg, 8 in Stanton; 400 events internationally; next year Marshall wants 100 people at the Burg ride

#### Advocacy Update

- The Planning Commission passed the Bicycle Pedestrian Plan, next the plan goes before City Council on July 13. Thomas wants to pack the room with very polite, well behaved cyclists. Last time such a plan came before City Council in 2005, we had 100 people. This time Thomas wants 200, but please not Dan Oates.

#### DCR grant update

- Background: we got \$100,000 grant from DCR for trail work. They provide 80% of it, we provide 20%, which we'll contribute in trail work (about 700 hours).
- First of the contract work is underway/completed, by E4 consulting out of North Carolina. They did two road-to-trail conversions. Next up is Trail Dynamics from North Carolina, which is a larger company.
- We still need about 400 volunteer hours for our match. Look out for GW forest trail work days on Saturdays this summer and fall.

#### Shenandoah Mountain Bike Festival – Columbus Day Weekend, Oct. 8 -11

- Length (btwn 1 and 3 days) will be determined by volunteer strength!
- We'll need 10 folks to fill critical leadership positions and responsibilities in order to have the full 3-day festival.
- Key people will each be responsible for a 4 hour chunk of the festival. If you would like to be one, email Thomas!! And go to planning meetings:
