- 4. Complete Traffic Skills 101 (aka Confident City Cycling) prior to the seminar.

(Note: There are no plans at this time to teach TS 101 in Harrisonburg for the remainder of 2013, due to preparations needed to bring the LCI Seminar here.)

Next, take the on-bike portion of the class with Thanh Dang, LCI #3414, for a fee of \$15/person. You will be provided with your own copy of the TS 101 course manual. The on-bike portion of the class will take approximately 5 hours.
